- **92%** of survey respondents said their knowledge about human trafficking increased.
- **90%** of survey respondents said they were better prepared to identify human trafficking.
- 87% of survey respondents said they know what next steps to take in order to combat human trafficking.
- **97%** of survey respondents said they would recommend attending a briefing like this to others in their field.
